ONWARDS: FROM THE DESK OF THE GUIDANCE COUNSELLOR







September 2023:


World Peace Day






October Festival at Myer's!!!!

Participation of Myer's College students from grade 5, 6 and 7 in Pakistan Spelling Bee Competition.




