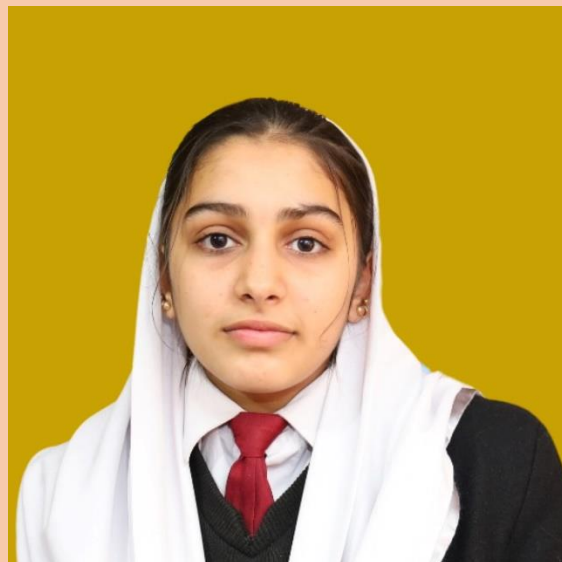

The creativity on display at the science fair and art exhibit was truly remarkable—testament to both student talent and teacher dedication.

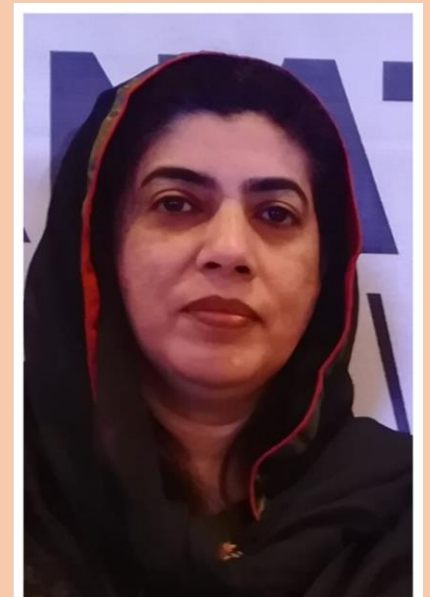
We also look forward to upcoming events such as the talent show, spring festival, and parent-teacher meetings, which offer wonderful opportunities to connect and celebrate our shared success.

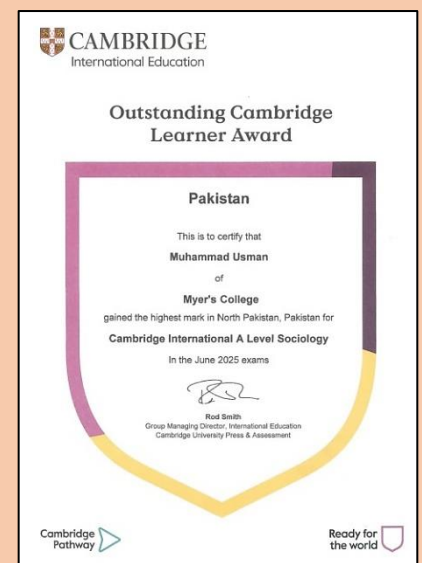

Honoring Our Heroes: Defence Day Celebrations at Myer's College

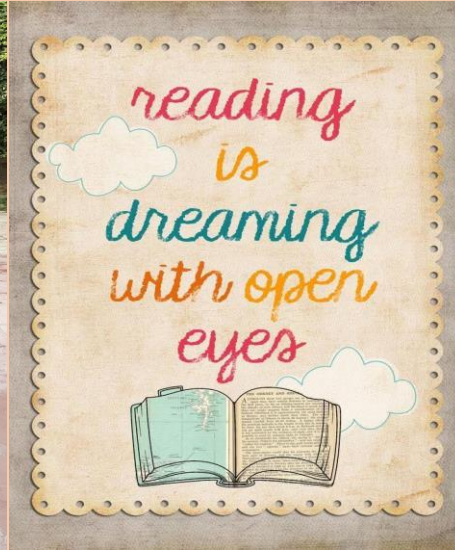

Junior School Hosts Engaging Reading Competitions

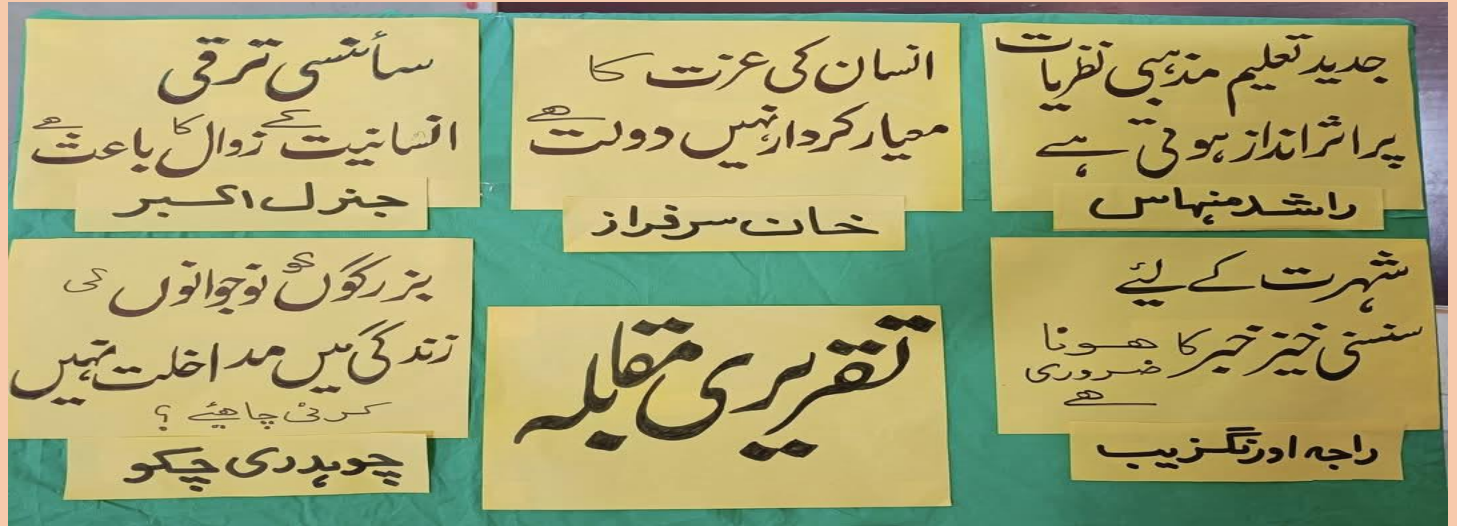

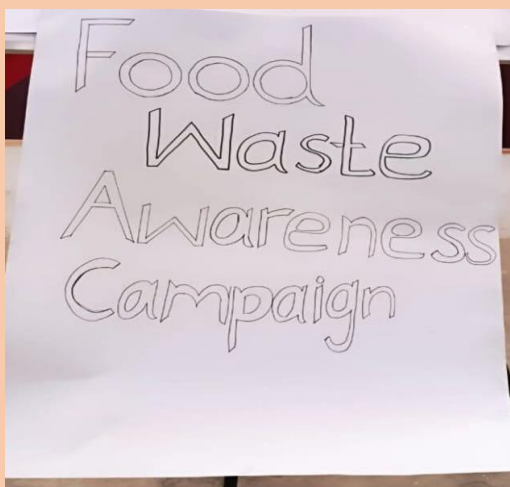

Senior School: MCMUN V Grand Finale – A Celebration of Diplomacy and Excellence

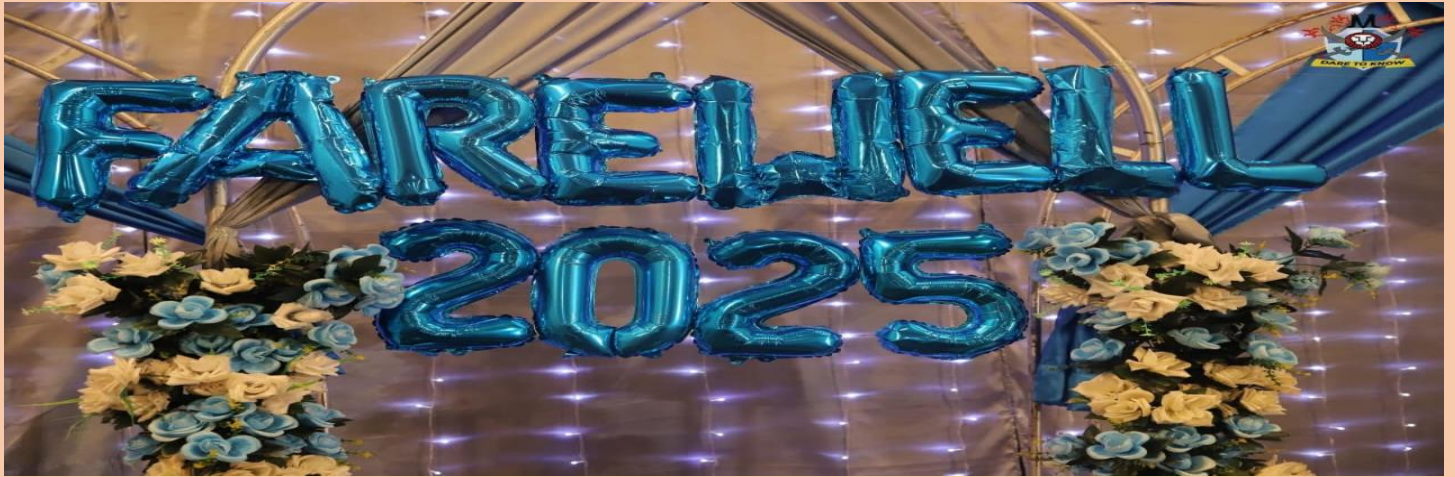
