Location & Institutional Context

Myer's College is a premier university-preparatory institution located in Chakwal, Punjab, Pakistan—a district of 1.5 million people, 81% of whom live in rural areas. As the first registered Cambridge O-Level and A-Level school in the region, Myer's College serves as a transformative academic hub for both urban and underserved rural communities.

Founded in 1999, the College is patterned after traditional English public schools in its ethos and academic rigor, while integrating the best of the U.S. education system through a semester-based structure, internal GPA tracking, and comprehensive transcripts. This hybrid model ensures students are prepared for both British and North American university systems, with a strong foundation in inquiry, leadership, and global citizenship.

The College currently enrolls ~1,000 students and owns a 100-acre campus near the Balkassar-Motorway Interchange, with current operations based at the Kot Sarfraz Khan Campus in Chakwal city.

Academic Program

- Affiliation: Cambridge International Examinations (O & A Levels)
- Structure: Internal credit-hour system (30–32 per semester) for academic tracking
- Schedule: Seven classes daily (Mon–Thu: 40 mins; Fri: 30 mins)
- Pedagogy: Inquiry-based, interdisciplinary, globally benchmarked

Compulsory: English, Urdu, Mathematics, Pakistan Studies, Islamiyat

Grading & Academic Standing

- Assessment System: Students are evaluated through internal coursework, projects, mock exams, and final external assessments administered by CAIE.
- GPA & Rank: Myer's College maintains an internal GPA (4.0 scale) and class rank based on cumulative performance from Grade 1 onward. Rankings are updated each semester.

Myers College reports grades on an unweighted 4.0 GPA scale. The school does not apply additional weight for advanced coursework, including Cambridge International A-Level and AS-Level subjects. However, our students routinely pursue these rigorous courses across diverse disciplines, demonstrating strong academic commitment and intellectual depth.

A 4.0 GPA at Myers College therefore reflects outstanding academic performance in a highly challenging curriculum, rather than grade inflation. We respectfully request that university admissions committees evaluate student achievement within this academic context.

Graduation Criteria

Graduation from Myer's College requires successful completion of both Cambridge O Level and post-secondary coursework, culminating in either AS Level or A Level examinations depending on the student's academic track. To qualify for graduation, students must:

- Complete all internally taught subjects, including those not examined by CAIE
- Successfully finish assigned projects and coursework
- Pass the college-administered Send-Up Exams to be eligible for CAIE registration
- Sit for either AS Level (Grade 12) or A Level (Grade 13) exams based on university goals

Students pursuing standard high school graduation typically sit for AS Level exams after 12 years of study. Those seeking advanced standing or university credit (e.g., AP equivalency) complete full A Level qualifications in selected subjects.

Upon graduation, each student receives:

- A Cambridge O Level certificate
- A Cambridge AS or A Level certificate (based on track)
- A Myer's College transcript detailing all courses completed, grades earned, and GPA—modeled on U.S. high school reporting standards to support global university applications

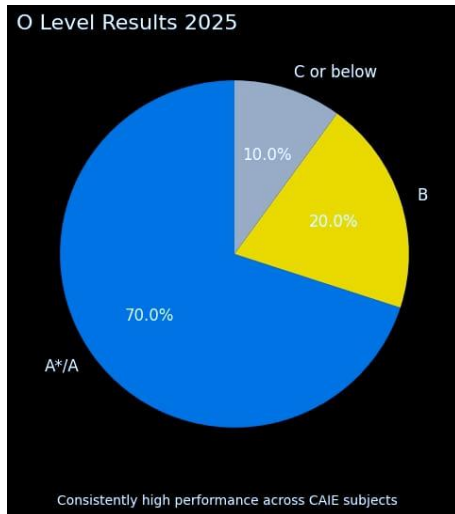

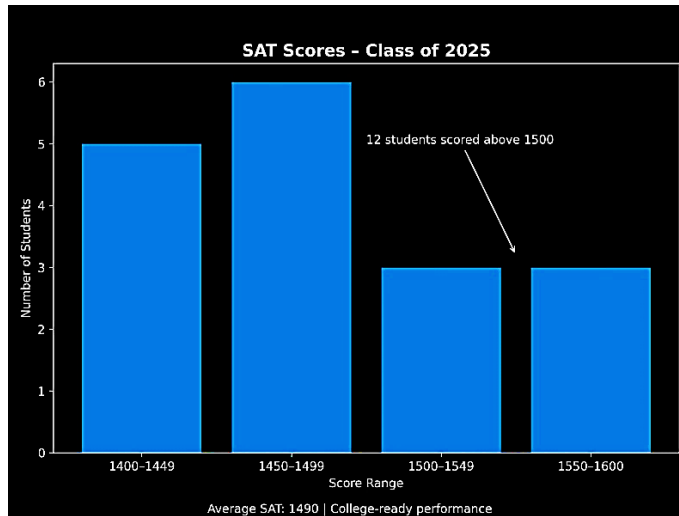

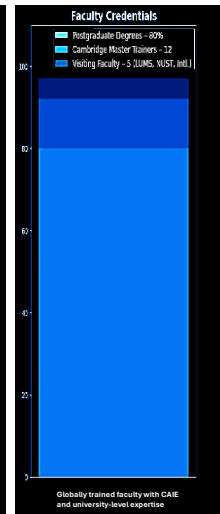
O Level Results 2025
